CATTLE eat plants that people cannot digest. Beef provides a source of protein and is part of a nutritious diet.



The main job of a feedlot is to help cattle grow bigger and stronger by keeping them healthy and happy and giving them nutritious food.



CATTLE have coats (like dogs) that help them stay warm in the winter months and shed to help them keep cool in the summer.

CATTLE in feedlots have fresh, clean water.



Manure from cattle contains nutrients that plants need. Cattle producers recycle nutrients by applying manure to the land. This can improve soil health in agricultural ecosystems.



A feedlot is like a big farm where cattle go to eat lots of good food that helps them grow strong.



Families who run feedlots take care of the cattle, making sure they are healthy and growing well. They work with veterinarians who help them keep the cattle healthy.
