## ALBERTA HAS THE MOST BEEF CATTLE


Feedlots can range in size from a few hundred to several thousand cattle.



The main job of a feedlot is to help cattle grow bigger and stronger by keeping them healthy and happy and giving them nutritious food.



**CATTLE** have coats (like dogs) that help them stay warm in the winter months and shed to help them keep cool in the summer.

in feedlots have fresh, clean water.



Manure from cattle contains nutrients that plants need. Cattle producers recycle nutrients by applying manure to the land. This can improve soil health in agricultural ecosystems.
